# WG1: INTEGRATED INTERFACE TO EUROPEAN DICTIONARY CONTENT

The first working group will investigate how authoritative dictionary information on the languages of Europe can be made accessible to both the general and academic public. It will:

- set up a European dictionary portal, which will give information on scholarly dictionaries of the languages of Europe and provide access to these dictionaries;
- investigate the possibilities of interlinking the contents of European dictionaries;
- investigate user requirements with respect to the presentation of dictionary content;
- investigate the possible involvement of users in the creation of dictionary content.
