



Services for older people have long suffered from duplication and fragmentation, especially in the overlap between health and social care. The division between health and social care responsibilities can be a barrier and a source of frustration to service users. The lack of integration between the different systems (health, social and housing) in several countries can introduce important barriers to implementation and to achievement of benefits. In addition, within the health system in particular, the lack of structures and processes to support continuity of care and integration of care between the different players and levels (hospital and primary care, general practitioners and specialists) are an important limiting factor for homecare development. The proposed solution will allow:





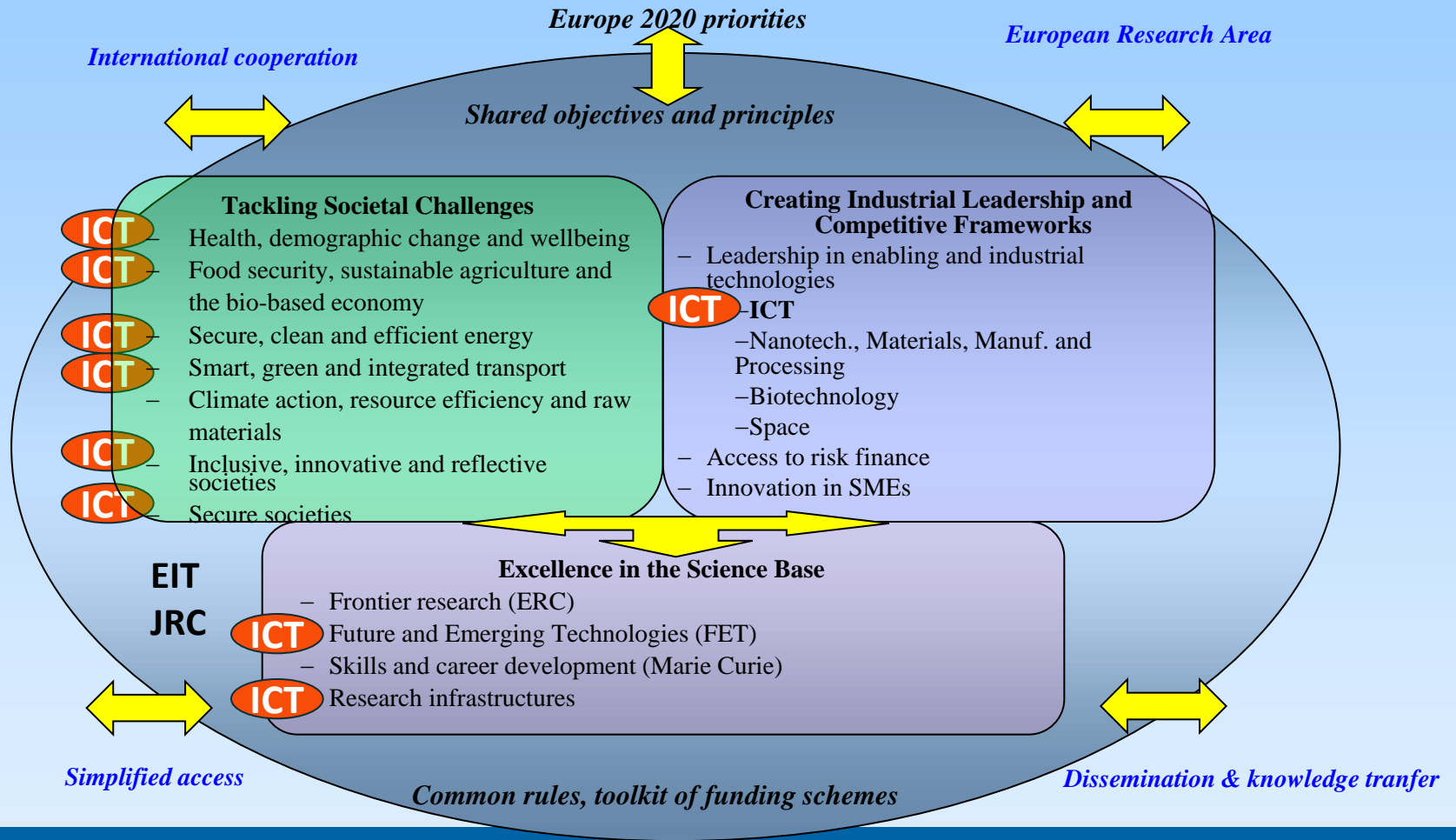
