Annual report of the year 2012 Department of Lexicology and Lexicography

Main tasks in the reporting year

The primary task at the Department is to write, revise and standardize the entries of letter *c*-dzs and *e* for the *Comprehensive Dictionary of Hungarian*, as well as to compile the *New Etymological Dictionary of Hungarian*.

Outstanding research and other results in 2012

The written entries of Vol. 5 of Comprehensive Dictionary of Hungarian were revised, standardized, and assigned with morphological codes. The compilation of the list of headwords beginning with e- \acute{e} progressed. Entries of such headwords were written. The bibliographical database of the sources and the bibliographical data in the entries were corrected. Approximately 1690 entries were completed and 1500 were revised and standardized. The work on the expansion of the corpus database, that is necessary because of its ill-proportioned structure and the need of raising the end date of the sources, commenced. The work on the New Etymological Dictionary of Hungarian also progressed with the exploration of a new amount of etymological literature (periodicals and monographs) and with the recording of entries of the three volumes of TESz. and two volumes of EWUng. were recorded in the revised ÚESz. entry structure, in accordance with the refined database building aspects. Almost 10,500 entries were assembled with the XMetaL6 program, in DTD format. The translation of the etymological parts of the EWUng. entries from German to Hungarian with the help of the MemoQ 6 translation support software. The efficiency of the automatic translation increased to 80%. The first version of half of the entries of headwords beginning with letter a (approximately 8900 lines) was completed. It was observed that the earlier solutions can be used later in the translation of other entires, and thus the translation will be faster.

Six of the staff members proceeded with their research and their activity in higher education and scientific public life. Three colleagues continued their doctoral studies.

One of the staff members worked with the support of Bolyai Research Scholarship on his author dictionary on Attila József's œuvre. The structure and the concept of the dictionary matured. The corpus database was compiled: the corpus of Attila József's full œuvre. From this, a concordance was created with computer, as well as the appendices processing the lyrical œuvre: the rhyme dictionary and the metrical database. Test entries of the headwords beginning with C and D were written.

In the project of *Comprehensive Dictionary of Hungarian*, the entries of headwords beginning with *c-dzs* were revised, standardized, and assigned with morphological codes;

the chief edition commenced. The compilation of the list of e, \acute{e} headwords progressed. Entries of such headwords were written. The work on the *New Etymological Dictionary of Hungarian* also progressed with the procession of a new amount of etymological literature, and with recording the data from TESz. and EWUng. entries, in accordance with the refined database building aspects. The translation of the etymological parts of the EWUng. entries from German to Hungarian also commenced, with the help of the MemoQ 6 translation support software.

Dialogue between science and society

Staff members of the department delivered informative presentations and published articles for the interested non-scientific audience in the field of linguistics, especially lexicography.

Three of the staff members participated in NEFMI's project titled *Helyzetkép a magyar nyelvről*. They worked on the themes of churches and Hungarian language, economic life and Hungarian language, as well as theater, film and Hungarian language. They compiled the material for discussion and summarized the proposals and evaluation of the debates.

One of the staff members participated in the work of the committee that assesses the forename requests and in the work of the geographical names comittee

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Presentation of national and international relations in 2012

Five of the staff members participated in higher eduction, teaching at the Department of Hungarian Linguistics of the PPCU Faculty of Humanities, at the Department of Hungarian Linguistics at the University of Miskolc, and at the Department of Hungarian Linguistics at the Pannon University.

Three of the staff members continued their doctoral studies and five other members continued their work in scientific public life. Two colleagues submitted their PhD theses.

The staff members are active in eight scientific societies, in the editorial board of four journals and series of collection of papers.

Objectives for the year 2013

The two ongoing projects at the Department of Lexicology and Lexicography in 2013 are the compilation of the *Comprehensive Dictionary of Hungarian* and the *New Etymological Dictionary of Hungarian*, in addition, one of the staff members works on an author dictionary on Attila József's œuvre supported by the Bolyai research fund.

In 2013, the revision, lexicographical standardization, morphological coding, and the chief editorial revision of the material of the *Comprehensive Dictionary of Hungarian Vol. 5. (C-de)* will be finished, and the volume will be published. The work on the entries of headwords Di-dzs, and the compilation of the entry list, as well as the writing of new entries (E, \acute{E}) will progress. The expansion of the ill-proportioned historical corpus' earlier version with new texts from the period 1772–2000 will be completed.

The collection of sources of etymology and word history for the *New Etymological Dictionary* of *Hungarian* will also progress; the data on word history will be revised. The translation of the etymological parts will be finished as a first draft. The supplementation of bibliographical parts, and the compilation of the etymological part of new entries will be in progress.
